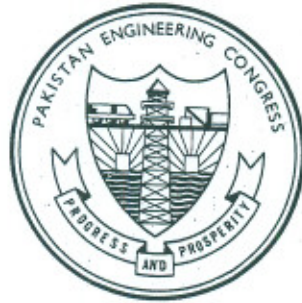

LIFE SKETCH OF THE
PRESIDENT FOR 59TH SESSION (1983-84)

Engr. Daud Beg, born in August, 1931 at Mardan, the President for the 59th Session of Pakistan Engineering Congress, is General Manager (Distribution) in WAPDA. Prior to his current assignment, he was Member (Power), Pakistan Atomic Energy Commission from 1978 to 1983. He has broad-based professional experience, both at home and abroad. He was appointed Chief Executive and General Manager of State Electrical Corporation of Pakistan in 1973 at the time of take-over of the bankrupt electrical industry, ECOP. In five years, the production had increased more than 15 times by diversification into sophisticated Control and Relay Panels, and the company had become a profitable concern.

He was the first Pakistani electrical engineer to be sent on deputation to Electricity Corporation of Nigeria in 1964, where he served for 8 years as Senior Executive (Planning and Design). He pioneered the way for hundreds of Pakistani engineers who have admirably served in Nigeria in senior appointments.

At the time of creation of East Pakistan WAPDA, he was sent on deputation as Director (Power). He worked in East Pakistan from 1960 to 1963, where he planned and engineered the interconnected Grid System.

Mr. Daud Beg has a brilliant academic career, having secured first position in all Engineering Examinations, and setting up a record in Second Engineering Examination. He was awarded Mclagan Gold Medal and Pollard Prize. He also stood first in Matriculation Examination in Lahore Division. He has won merit scholarships throughout the period of his education.

Mr. Beg holds an honours degree in Electrical Engineering, and post-graduate D.I.C. in Hydro-Power Engineering from Imperial College, London. He is one of the few engineers, who are professionally qualified in Electrical, Mechanical and Civil Engineering. While in U.K., he worked for North of Scotland Hydro Electric Board and Central Electricity Generating Board.

Mr. Beg is an individual Consultant to the World Bank and the Asian Development Bank and has carried out international assignments.

Mr. Daud Beg is a keen mountaineer. He was Founder Member and Secretary of the Karakoram Club of Pakistan from 1953 to 1955. He has been Vice-President of the Alpine Club of Pakistan since 1978. He has participated in expeditions to Trich Mir, Rakaposhi, Batura Mustagh and Malika Parbat, and climbed upto 23,500 feet. He was awarded tiger medal by German Alpine Club. He has also climbed in Norway, Switzerland and U.K, and has published more than 50 articles on exploration and adventure. He has a similar number of technical articles to his credit.

He has won College Colours in Badminton, Rover Scouting and Mountaineering.

He considers that one of the major achievements of the Pakistan Engineering Congress during his tenure of Presidency was the mid-term seminar on Karakoram Highway, when more than fifty senior engineers were able to visit Hunza and Nagir Valleys, so called "Shangri-LA" because of their enchanting beauty.
